- Student can opt for A.G. or Exam or Both
- You should opt for both ; you must opt for A.G.

School Based Phase

- a) **Teacher Estimated Mark**
- b) Subject Group Alignment
- c) Oversight by Principal



Teacher Estimated Mark

- Professional Judgement
- Student likely performance in written and component
- No class rank – differentiated mark



Reaching an Estimated Mark

- All assessments over 2 years of study
- Assignments, projects, practical work
- Class assessments, house exams
- Evidence of learning during lockdown
- Coursework component
- **Additional Assessments**



Additional Assessments

- Up to May 14th
- In Class

- May be written, aural, oral or practical
